	She went onto to explain that Cllr from Fulford was looking to join forces with Forsbrook to target Stallington Road.

It was resolved to ask the Clerk to Object</li> <li>Grants were available for outside art projects up to £1000 but not for the Lengthsman.</li> <li>Cheadle Hospital – The NHS only needed to give 12 weeks' notice of a closure, the next hospitals under threat were Bradwell, and Leek</li> <li>There is to be a training day at the Library on November 2<sup>nd</sup> 1 – 3pm for Olive Branch. This is a scheme which encourages people to check on their neighbours and equips them with the skills to risk assess peoples living space for things like fire and trip hazards.</li> <li>Community Right to Bid – This is a scheme where communities with community building at threat ie old public houses being earmarked for housing can register the building as a community asset, this then gives the community 6 months to raise the funds</li> </ol>	CLERK
