District Cllr Flunder – Concerns over broadband speeds in rural villages.

The shared prosperity fund has been granted to SMDC 3.4 million over two years. Cllr Herdman – Surgery updates – A resident was concerned over the road closures and traffic lights. Cllr Herdman explained that unfortunately that the works need to be done and we will have to put up with it for the greater good.

Cllr McCready expressed concerns about the lack of joined up thinking regarding other road closures.
